2020-2021 Presidential Priorities

Increase Membership Involvement/Engagement

- Project-based work
 - -Streamlined system for pitching projects to the RT Board for consideration
- •Quarterly (minimum) town halls
- •State Association presence/partnerships

Increase Communication with Membership

- •Bi-monthly or monthly newsletters
- Streamlined social media processes
- •Website overhaul

Increase Documentation and Archiving of Board and RT processes and history

- •Handbook(s) or similar project/role one-sheets/guides
- Annual Reports
- •Use of comics/illustration within RT resources/documentation

Increase Diversity, Inclusion, & Accessibility in the RT and Comics Industry

- •Scholarship opportunities for RT & ALA membership, future conference/convention attendance
- •Increased targeted partnerships with ALA Affiliate groups BCALA, AILA, APALA, Reforma. Goal: JCLC appearance
- •Inclusion of creators and publishers at varying levels of professional visibility, e.g. new creators, self-published, small press in addition to established or big 5 (regular publishing) or big 2 (comics)
- •Outlined expectations of regular diverse representation on panels/presentations (not just those centering topics of diversity), to include but not be limited to:
 - -Race/ethnicity
 - -Gender & Sexuality
 - -Neurodiversity
 - -Dis/abled
 - -Geography
 - --rural/suburban/city
 - --State
 - --Region
 - --Country
 - -Library type
 - --Academic
 - --Public
 - --School
 - --Special
 - -Audience age (childrens, teen, adult)
- •Captions added to all online content for the Deaf/Hard of Hearing community
- •Create a pre-recorded content catalog (not always with the intent of a livestream first)
- •Operate outside paywalls (conference/convention costs are prohibitive) and make content free when possible
