#### **Best Fiction for Young Adults**

This is a compilation of the current year's works of young adult fiction (excluding graphic novels) with proven or potential appeal to teens.

#### **Great Graphic Novels for Teens**

This annual list recommends graphic novels—both fiction and nonfiction

#### **Outstanding Books for the College Bound**

Updated every five years, this comprehensive list provides reading recommendations to students who plan to continue their education beyond high school. Organized by subject area, this lists contains both works of fiction and nonfiction. A compilation of this list is available as a book by the same name.

#### **Popular Paperbacks for Young Adults**

The purpose of this annual group of lists is to encourage young adults to read for pleasure by presenting them with popular or topical books with teen appeal. Organized by genre, there can be up to five different lists of recommended books each year.

#### **Quick Picks for Reluctant Young Adult Readers**

The purpose of this annual list is to identify works of fiction and nonfiction for recreational reading that have wide appeal to teens who, for whatever reason, do not like to read.

### **Amazing Audiobooks for Young Adults**

This annual list presents audiobooks, both fiction and nonfiction, released within the past two years that appeal to teens.

## Teens' Top Ten

This annual list is a teen choice award given to selected current publications that are of special interest to teens. It is a project of YALSA's YA Galley Committee. Teens vote for their choices starting August 15th-Teen Read Week. The votes are tallied and the top ten is announced after Teen Read Week.
