This action planning tool can help you create steps to address one aspect of youth homelessness.

In the first column, list a need of the young people we've talked about today. In the second column, list one action you/your library could take to meet this need. The next column asks for one asset you/your library already has that could help (e.g., a partnership, a supportive library board, funds, etc.). The following three columns help break down your plan into action steps. First, think of three steps you/your library could take to move forward on this action. Then, identify potential barriers that could arise as you/your library begin(s) to take these steps, and finally, list strategies you could use for addressing those barriers.
